The NSS unit of Jyothy Institute of Technology (JIT), Tataguni Bengaluru organized blood donation camp in collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society, Race Course Road , Bengaluru, on 27th December 2025. The camp began at 10.00 a.m. with a short inaugural function where in Dr. Jayathritha M Patil, Asst. Professor and NSS Coordinator of JIT along with Mr. Sathish, program coordinator from Indian Red cross society inaugurated the blood camp.

Mr.Sathish expressed his gratitude to the NSS unit of the college for its continuous endeavor in this regard. He also stressed on the growing need of blood in the country and commended the young

volunteers for their noble act. Also, he gave overview of statistics about blood donation in our country that, we need about 12 million units of blood every year but just 9 million units are being donated. India faces a blood shortage of 3 million units every year, this problem can be addressed if an additional two percent of Indians donate blood. Jyothy Institute Technology, Under NSS unit has been regularly organizing blood donation camp every year and students and the faculty members come forward voluntarily to donate blood. About 154 volunteers came forward to donate blood during the camp which included teaching Staff, non-teaching staff and student donors. At the end 109 units of Blood was collected.

The blood donors were given apple, banana, biscuits and Fruit beverage after donating the blood in order to reenergize themselves. The blood donors were provided with a blood donation certificate by Indian Red Cross Society for Volunteering the camp. the Entire blood camp was volunteered by final year Mechanical engineering Students in coordination with Mechanical Engineering staff The Blood donation camp was concluded in presence of Shri. Narasimhan, Vice Chairperson Jyothy Charitable Trust (JCT), Shri. B K Ramesh, Honorable Trustee, JCT, Dr. K Gopalakrishna, Principal, JIT, and Dr. C B Mohan, Vice principal, JIT. Principal addressed the gathering about importance of blood donation and why it is important to donate blood every year. Finally, to conclude Mr. Sathish and his medical team handed over Institution participation certificate to the management and principal.
